5. Police Department – May 2022

Borough Clerk Harris announced that should any additional reports be received; they shall be provided to the Mayor and Council as soon as possible.

**FOR THE GOOD OF THE BOROUGH**

Borough Clerk Harris asked prior to entertaining a motion to adjourn if there was anything further anyone wanted to offer for the “good of the Borough”.

Councilwoman Evaristo moved to recess the Regular Meeting and go into Executive Session. The Motion was seconded by Councilman Graham and seconded by Councilwoman Zincavage and approved unanimously by voice vote.

Borough Clerk Harris stated that the reasons for going into Executive Session pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-12(b) were to discuss: (1) tactics and techniques utilized in protecting the safety and property of the public, provided that their disclosure could impair that protection, or investigations of violations or possible violations of the law pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-12(b)(6); and (2) pending or anticipated

litigation or contract negotiation other than in subsection b. (4) herein in which the public body is, or may become, a party, or matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required in order for the attorney to exercise his ethical duties as a lawyer pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:4-12(b)(7).

Borough Clerk Harris stated that minutes of the Executive Session shall be kept and made public at such time as the Borough Attorney deemed that the confidentiality of the topics discussed in Executive Session were no longer found to exist.

The Regular Meeting recessed at 7:28 P.M. and members of the public were excused; subjected to being readmitted once Executive Session concluded and the Regular Meeting resumed.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION**

Executive Session commenced at 7:29 P.M..

Mayor Grilo and Interim Borough Administrator Catrambone discussed with Council Members the proposed Ordinance to Amend the Borough Code to allow for parking meters. Issues discussed included location, time, costs, possible exceptions (particularly for those residents who have residential and non-residential parking permits). Modifications and amendments were proposed to the Ordinance as presently written based on questions and comments by all present.

Having nothing further to discuss in Executive Session; Councilman Graham moved that Executive Session be adjourned and the Regular Meeting resume. The motion was seconded by Councilwoman Evaristo and approved unanimously on voice vote. Executive session concluded at 7:53 P.M..

**RESUMPTION OF REGULAR MEETING**

The Regular Meeting resumed at 7:54 P.M., and all members present before the Executive Session were still present.

There were no items presented that were deemed “for the good of the Borough” and Borough Clerk Harris closed this portion of the meeting.

**ORDINANCE FOR FIRST READING**

This matter was tabled from earlier in the meeting and discussed by the Mayor and Council during Executive Session. Upon recommendation of Borough Attorney Cifelli, the Mayor and Council decided to table this Ordinance until the July 13, 2022 Regular Meeting to allow for the Ordinance to be modified pursuant to the issues raised during Executive Session.

Councilman Reis asked if the residents potentially affected should be given notice. Borough Clerk Harris responded that the time to do that is after the Ordinance is introduced, but before the date for Public Hearing and Second Reading.
