MEETING MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

The Regular Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of East Newark was called to order at 5:30 P.M., by Borough Clerk Kevin D. Harris.

There was one (1) member(s) of the public present for the meeting this evening.

Borough Clerk Harris informed the Mayor and Council that a quorum had been established.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Councilwoman Evaristo moved that the Mayor and Council go into Executive Session to discuss various issues. Ms. Ross spoke to the Mayor and Council and commended them on the appointment of Fred Confessore as the Borough's next Administrator.

Ms. Ross further expressed concern about being excluded from the meeting. Borough Clerk Harris asked Ms. Ross when she was excluded from a meeting to which Ms. Ross advised when the Mayor and Council went into Executive Session. Borough Clerk Harris explained to Ms. Ross
