**RESOLUTION APPROVING COMCAST’S APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL
OF MUNICIPAL CONSENT TO CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE A CABLE TV SYSTEM
IN THE BOROUGH OF EAST NEWARK, COUNTY OF HUDSON**

WHEREAS, there is a need for cable television services in the Borough of East Newark; and

WHEREAS, Comcast Cablevision Corporation, d/b/a Comcast Cablevision submitted an “Application for Renewal of Municipal Consent to Construct and Operate a Cable TV System in the Borough of East Newark, County of Hudson” to the Borough and filed with the Borough on or about July 14, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Comcast Cablevision Corporation, d/b/a Comcast Cablevision present its application to the Borough Council in a public hearing on October 9, 2024,

WHEREAS, the Borough believes that providing cable tv services to the Borough residents is inherently beneficial and where the Mayor and Council desire to continue the cable tv services currently being provided; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of East Newark, in the County of Hudson, State of New Jersey, do hereby grant consent to Comcast Cablevision Corporation, d/b/a Comcast Cablevision’s “Application for Renewal of Municipal Consent to Construct and Operate a Cable TV System in the Borough of East Newark, County of Hudson”; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a draft of an ordinance amending Certain Sub-Chapters Of Chapter 24 Titled “Comcast Cablevision Corporation, D/B/A Comcast Cablevision, Franchise Renewal Ordinance” To Establish The Borough’s Consent To Comcast’s Application For Renewal Of Municipal Consent To Construct And Operate A Cable Tv System In The Borough Of East Newark, County Of Hudson, will be filed with Office of Cable Television within the time prescribed by the applicable state regulations.
